Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the fee paid to a witness to attend a circuit court is \$16 per day of attendance. This bill allows the county board to establish a higher fee. The amount established for witness fees is also the fee paid to witnesses in hearing before office of credit unions and before the savings bank review board.
