

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 699**

February 29, 2000 – Offered by Representative LA FAVE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 16: delete “sub. (4),” and substitute “subs. (3g) and (4),”.

3 **2.** Page 4, line 6: after that line insert:

4 “**(3g)** EXEMPTION FROM PROHIBITION FOR CERTAIN PRISONERS. A person who is
5 prohibited from possessing body armor under sub. (2) may wear body armor if he or
6 she is in the actual custody of a law enforcement officer, as defined in s. 165.85 (2)
7 (c), or a correctional officer, as defined in s. 102.475 (8) (a), and is wearing the body
8 armor at the request or direction of the law enforcement officer or correctional
9 officer.”.

10 **3.** Page 4, line 7: delete “EXEMPTION.” and substitute “REQUEST BY CERTAIN
11 PERSONS FOR COMPLETE OR PARTIAL EXEMPTION FROM PROHIBITION.”.
