The Governor's Office would like to introduce a **bill that** creates 4.0 **FTE** GPR-funded assistant district attorney (ADA) positions. Accordingly, I **am** writing to request a draft **that** would create these positions.

Possible language could be:

ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT **ATTORNEY** POSITIONS.

(a) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of administration under section 20.475 (1) (d) of the statutes, as **affected** by the acts of 1999, the dollar amount is increased by \$47,900 for fiscal year 1999-2000 and \$19 1,600 for fiscal **year** 2000-01 to increase the authorized **FTE** positions for **the** department of administration by 4.0 **GPR** positions beginning with the **effective** date of this bill, for assistant district attorney positions.

(b) The department of administration shall consult with the Wisconsin District Attorneys Association to determine the office location of these positions. The department. of administration shall consider **the** recommendation of the Wisconsin District Attorneys Association.

It should be clearly stated in the bill that the location **of** these positions will be made by **the** Department of **Administration (DOA)** after consultation **with** the Wisconsin District Attorneys **Association (WDAA)**.



I am **writing** to request a revision to the recent assistant district attorney (ADA) position draft (LRB #4281/ 1). **This** revision provides 5.0 FTE, rather than 4.0 **FTE**.

Accordingly, the **dollar** figures and FTE count in the language must be changed. To increase the number of **ADA** positions from four to five, the dollar amount should be increased to \$59,900 for fiscal year 1999-2000 and \$239,500 for fiscal year 2000-01. The number of positions cited on page 2 line 3 should be increased to 5.0 **FTE**.
