Subject: Drafting Instructions for **Additional** Probation and Parole Agents

The Governor's Office would like to introduce a bill to fund the creation of 100.0 GPR funded **FTE** positions for the Division of Community Corrections in the Department of Corrections (DOC). In addition, the bill is to increase funding to purchase more programming services for offenders. Accordingly, I am writing to request a bill draft that will create and fund these positions and programs.

Increase 20.410 (l)(b) (Services for community corrections) - by **\$5,016,700** GPR and 100.0 GPR funded **FTE**.

Increase 20.410 (l)(d) (Purchased services for offenders) - by **\$1,744,600** GPR.

The purpose of these increases is to improve public safety and enhance probation and parole supervision and services in Milwaukee County.

The effective date for the new funding **and** positions is **7/1/00**.

Yesterday (1/25/00), I sent over drafting instructions to fund the creation of 100.0 GPR funded FTE positions for the Division of Community Corrections in the Department of Corrections (DOC). In addition, the instructions increased funding to purchase more programming services for offenders. I am writing to reduce the funding request to reflect the phase-in of the new agent positions. The year-end total will still be 100.0 GPR FTE, but the agents will be gradually phased-in throughout the year. Please reduce the funding request to reflect this phase-in. The request for purchase of service funding is unchanged for the original drafting request.

The new request is to increase 20.410 (l)(b) (**Services** for community corrections) - by **\$3,484,700 GPR** and 100.0 GPR funded **FTE**.

The effective date for the new funding and positions is **7/1/00**.

Under current law, a person who is on probation, parole or extended supervision as the result of a criminal conviction is in the legal custody of the department of corrections (DOC) and is supervised by a probation, parole or extended supervision agent. This bill increases by 100 the number of ~~probation, parole and extended supervision agents that DOC may employ~~ beginning July 1, 2000. The new positions must be used to supervise persons on probation or parole in Milwaukee County.

Current law also provides that DOC may contract with public, private or voluntary agencies for the purchase of goods, care and services for persons on probation or parole. The services that DOC may contract for include diagnostic services, evaluation, treatment, counseling, referral and information, special education, vocational training, work adjustment, sheltered employment and special living arrangements. This bill provides DOC with an additional \$1,744,600 in fiscal year 2000-01 so that DOC can purchase goods, care and services for persons on probation or parole in Milwaukee County.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Appropriation changes.

(1) PROBATION, PAROLE AND EXTENDED SUPERVISION AGENTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of corrections under section 20.410 (1) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1999, the dollar amount is increased by ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ \$3,548,900 for fiscal year 2000-01 to increase the authorized FTE positions for the department of corrections effective July 1, 2000, by 100.0 GPR ~~probation, parole and extended supervision agent~~ positions to be used to supervise persons on probation or parole in Milwaukee County.

(2) PURCHASE OF SERVICES FOR PERSONS ON PROBATION OR PAROLE. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of corrections under section 20.410 (1) (d) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1999, the dollar amount is increased by \$1,744,600 for fiscal year 2000-01 to purchase goods, care and services for persons on probation or parole in Milwaukee County.
