Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) erects tourist-oriented directional signs to assist motorists traveling along highways. Tourist-oriented directional signs provide identification of and directional information for tourist-related businesses, services or activities, which derive the majority of their income or visitors, during the normal business season from motorists not residing in the immediate area where the business, service or activity is located.

This bill requires DOT, upon receiving an application and applicable fees, to erect two touristcoriented directional signs along USH 18 in Grant County, for Wisconsin Badger Camp, a nonprofit corporation was a long of the county.

For further information **see** the **state** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

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The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.** 

(1) TOURIST ORIENTED DIRECTIONAL SIGNS FOR WISCONSIN BADGER CAMP IN GRANT

County. Notwithstanding the eligibility criteria established under section 86.196 of

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the statutes, upon application and payment of fees ordinarily required for the erection of tourist-oriented directional signs, the department of transportation shall erect two signs meeting the specifications under section 86.196 of the statutes, and rules promulgated under that section, for Wisconsin Badger Camp, located in signs shall be erected along USH 18 at the intersection of USH 18 and Military Ridge Road, approximately the line west of the city of Emninote in Grant County.

Because this bill requires the erection of signs in 'the right-of-way of a federal highway, this bill might violate federal outdoor advertising restrictions, or agreements between this state and the federal government for control of outdoor advertising, and might therefore decrease the amount of federal highway funds or federal incentive payments received by this state. I recommend that DOT review this draft closely.
