Representative Brandemuehl:

Because this substitute amendment requires the erection of signs in the right-of-way of a federal highway, this substitute amendment might violate federal outdoor advertising restrictions, or agreements between this state and the federal government for control of outdoor advertising, and might therefore decrease the amount of federal highway funds or federal incentive payments received by this state. I recommend that DOT review this substitute amendment closely.

Specific information signs provide information for only 4 categories of motorist services. Do you want to specify whether Wisconsin Badger Camp, Inc., should be considered a gas, food, lodging or camping service?
