

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 731**

March 30, 2000 – Offered by Representative GROTHMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 8: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 4p.** 46.515 (6g) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 46.515 (**6g**) (b) A county or Indian tribe that is selected to participate in the  
5 program under this section shall provide or shall designate an individual or entity  
6 to provide an explanation of the confidentiality requirements under par. (a) to each  
7 individual who is offered an assessment under sub. (4) (b) or who is offered services  
8 under the home visitation program of the county or Indian tribe before that  
9 assessment or those services are offered. The explanation shall include notice that  
10 a provider of home visitation program services under this section who is required  
11 under s. 48.981 (2) to report any suspected or threatened abuse or neglect of a child  
12 seen in the course of the provider’s professional duties must report any suspected or

1 threatened abuse or neglect of a child seen in the course of providing those services  
2 and that, if a report is made, the agency, as defined in s. 48.981 (1) (ag), receiving the  
3 report will initiate an investigation of the report within 24 hours after receipt of the  
4 report.”.
