"Section 4p. 46.515 (6g) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

46.515 **(6g)** (b) A county or Indian tribe that is selected to participate in the program under this section shall provide or shall designate an individual or entity to provide an explanation of the confidentiality requirements under par. (a) to each individual who is offered an assessment under sub. (4) (b) or who is offered services under the home visitation program of the county or Indian tribe <u>before that</u> assessment or those services are offered. The explanation shall include notice that a provider of home visitation program services under this section who is required under s. 48.981 (2) to report any suspected or threatened abuse or neglect of a child seen in the course of the provider's professional duties must report any suspected or

- 2 and that, if a report is made, the agency, as defined in s. 48.981 (1) (ag), receiving the
