TO 1999 SB SJR SR AB AIR AR 746 (LRB)

At the locations indicated, amend the VA bill as follows:

(3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of justice, under section 20.455 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1995, the dollar amount is increased by \$80,200 for fiscal year 1996-97 to fund 1.5 FTE GPR project positions authorized under SECTION 35m (1) of this act.

SECTION 36. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies to the taking of a child or adult into custody under section 51.15 (1) of the statutes on the effective date of this subsection, to proceedings in which a petition is filed under section 51.20 (1) of the statutes on the effective date of this subsection and to proceedings in which an application for extension of a com-

mitment has been made under section 51.20 (13) (g) 3. of the statutes on the effective date of this subsection.

SECTION 37. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the first day of the 7th month beginning after publication, except as follows:

(1) The repeal and recreation of sections 51.15 (1) (a) (intro.), (4) (a) and (5), 51.20 (1) (a) 1. and (am), (7) (d) and (13) (dm), 51.35 (3) (c) and (e), 51.37 (5) (b) and 51.61 (1) (g) 2. and 3. of the statutes takes effect on the first day of the 67th month beginning after publication.

(2) The treatment of section 51.03 (3) of the statutes takes effect on the first day of the 4th month beginning after publication.

1995 WISCONSIN ACT 293

AN ACT to amend 29.104 (4) (a) 4. and 29.104 (4) (a) 5. of the statutes, relating to: verifying certain disabilities for the purpose of issuing crossbow hunting permits.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.104 (4) (a) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

29.104 (4) (a) 4. Has a permanent substantial loss of function in one or both arms or one or both hands and fails to meet the minimum standards of the standard upper extremity pinch, grip and 9-hole peg tests, administered un-

der the direction of a licensed physician or a licensed chiropractor.

SECTION 2. 29.104 (4) (a) 5. of the statutes is amended to read:

29.104 (4) (a) 5. Has a permanent substantial loss of function in one or both shoulders and fails to meet the minimum standards of the standard shoulder strength tests, administered under the direction of a licensed physician or a licensed chiropractor.

1995 WISCONSIN ACT 294

AN ACT to create 23.115 (3) of the statutes, relating to: inspection of certain snowmobile trails by the department of natural resources.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 23.115 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

NOTE: Corrects error in transcribing 1995 Wis. Act 27. This provision was inadvertently omitted from the statutes.

SECTION 596. 977.05 (6) (b) 1. of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, is amended to read:

977.05 (6) (b) 1. The action is not brought by the state, its delegate under s. 59.458 (1) 59.53 (6) (a) or an attorney appointed under s. 767.045 (1) (c).

NOTE 1995 Wis. Act 201 rennumbers s. 59.458 (1) to be s. 59.53 (6) (a) effective 9-1-96.

SECTION 597. The amendment of 977.076 (2) of the statutes by 1995 Wisconsin Act 352 is not repealed by 1995 Wisconsin Act 417. Both amendments stand.

NOTE There is no conflict of substance.

SECTION 598. The amendment of 978.05 (6) (a) of the statutes by 1995 Wisconsin Act 201 is not repealed by 1995 Wisconsin Act 448. Both amendments stand.

NOTE There is no conflict of substance.

SECTION 599. The amendment of 978.06 (6) of the statutes by 1995 Wisconsin Act 201 is not repealed by 1995 Wisconsin Act 404. Both amendments stand.

NOTE. There is no conflict of substance.

SECTION 600. 1995 Wisconsin Act 225, section 270 is amended by replacing "is renumbered" with "is amended".

NOTE The wrong action phrase was used.

SECTION 601. 1995 Wisconsin Act 225, section 551 (3) is amended to read:

[1995 Wisconsin Act 225] Section 551 (3) The treatment of sections 20.370 (7) (aa), 20.485 (2) (e), 111.02 (3) and 111.11 (1) (by SECTION 578) of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 1997.

NOTE: The effective date for the treatment of this provision was intended to correspond with the effective date of the treatment of that provision by 1995 Wis. Act 27, which was January 1, 1997. This section and the next section of this bill replace the wrong effective date with the correct one.

SECTION 602. 1995 Wisconsin Act 225, section 551 (4) is created to read:

[1995 Wisconsin Act 225] Section 551 (4) The treatment of section 20.485 (2) (c) of the statutes takes effect on January 1, 1997.

NOTE. See the note to the previous section of this bill.

SECTION 603. 1995 Wisconsin Act 302, section 54 (1) is amended to read:

[1995 Wisconsin Act 302] Section 54 (1) PROHIBITED SUBJECTS OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING. The treatment of section 111.91 (2) (k) (km), (L) and (m) of the statutes first applies to participants, who are affected by a collective bargaining agreement that contains provisions inconsistent with that treatment, on the day on which the collective bargaining agreement expires or is extended, modified or renewed, whichever occurs first.

NOTE: This bill rennumbers s. 111.91 (2) (k) to s. 111.91 (2) (km).

SECTION 604. 1995 Wisconsin Act 352, section 53, is amended by replacing "895.034 (2m) (b)" with "895.035 (2m) (b)".

NOTE: Inserts correct citation.

SECTION 605. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after publication, except as follows:

(1) The treatment of section 51.15 (1) (a) (intro.) (by SECTION NO TAG), (4) (a) (by SECTION NO TAG) and (5) (by SECTION NO TAG) of the statutes and the repeal and recreation of section 5 1.20 (7) (d) of the statutes takes effect on December 1, 2001. " takes

(2) The treatment of sections 48.57 (3p) (g) 3. and 349.135 of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 1997.

(3) The treatment of section 76.28 (4) (intro.) of the statutes takes effect on May 1, 1998.

(4m) The treatment of section 13.48 (18) of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 2002, or upon completion of acquisition of property sufficient for the construction of a facility to meet the space needs of the state law library, the legislative reference bureau library and legislative and judicial branch agencies and support staffs.
