

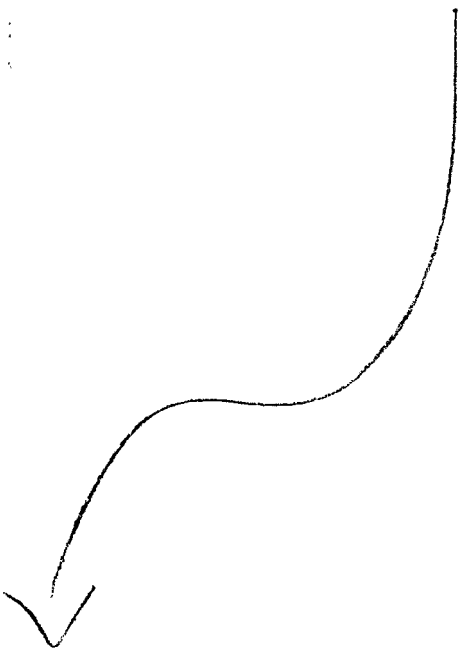

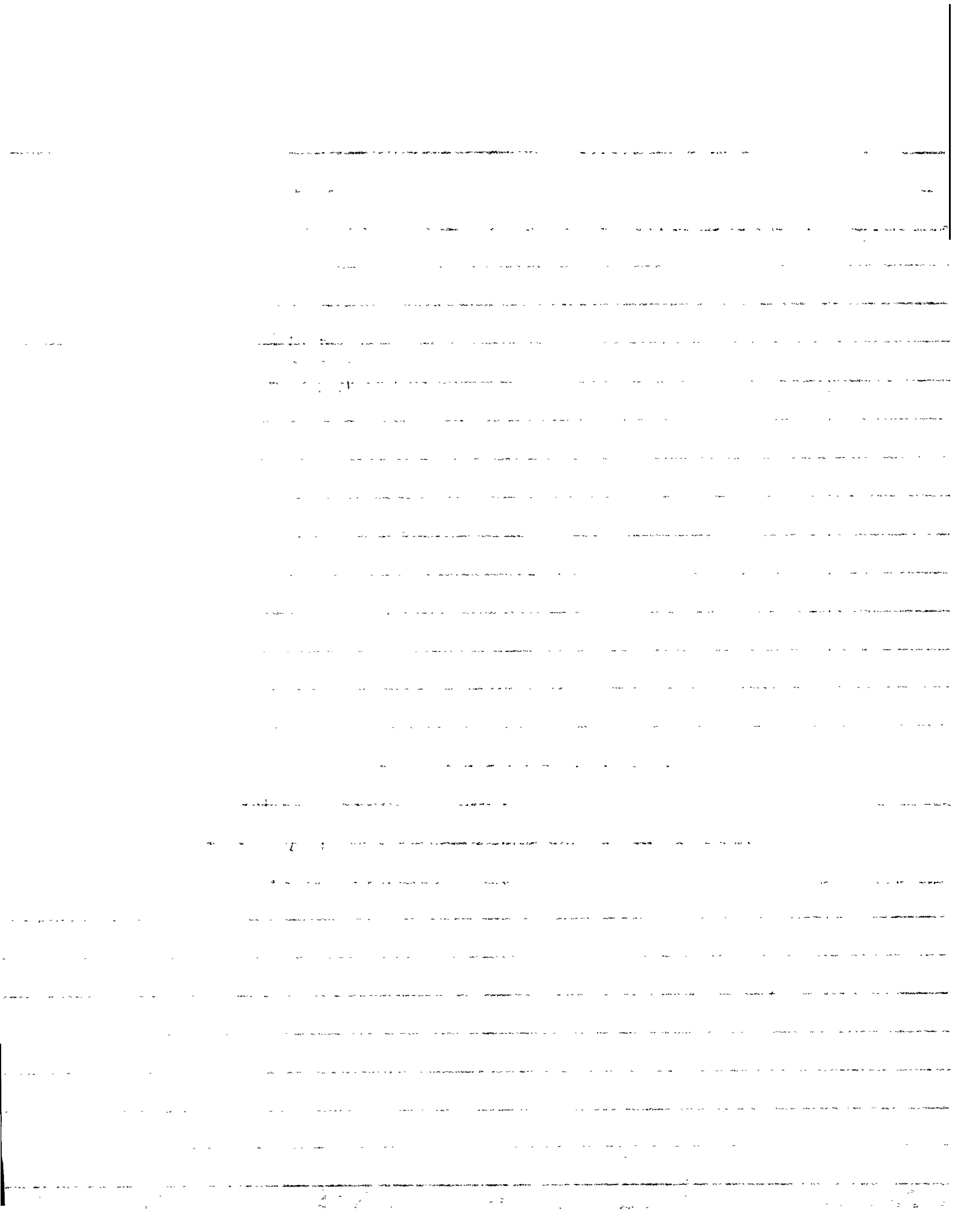

¶ Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) ^{may} issue one insert tag or decal for a vehicle whenever its registration is renewed in lieu of issuing ^{two} $\boxed{2}$ new registration plates or, for certain vehicles, one new registration plate. The vehicle owner is required to place the insert tag or decal on the rear (or, if only one registration plate is issued for the vehicle, the front) registration plate in the manner directed by DOT ¹.

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:

This LRB draft authorizes DOT to issue renewal stickers (termed in the statutes "tags" or "decals") for both the front registration plate and the rear registration plate. The draft clarifies the location of these stickers on the plate, and establishes a penalty of forfeiture of up to \$25 for failing to place the stickers in the proper location on the plate.

Annual cost:

Newly issued plates would require additional stickers for a cost of \$99,100 annually. For vehicles that already have plates, additional year stickers would be sent upon renewal for a cost of \$209,500 annually. In addition, beginning July 1, 2000, annually we will be reissuing new license plates for about 500,000 vehicles instead of merely sending stickers at renewal time. For these vehicles we would issue 4 stickers instead of 2 stickers for an added cost of \$64,000. Thus, total annual cost is \$372,600.

One-time cost:

The fleet of vehicles currently registered will receive two year stickers every year at renewal, but they need only receive an additional month sticker once. Therefore, for the first renewal cycle after this law goes into effect (to reach all the vehicles in the fleet which need a new month sticker), we must send a month sticker as well as the year stickers.

In order to accomplish this, we must make data processing modifications which will flag vehicle records to receive one (front) month sticker and then make sure the vehicle does not receive another one in future renewal or title transactions. Also, because at any given time we are renewing vehicles with any month expiration, we must program the system to issue the proper month sticker for the vehicle being renewed. This is done by programming the system to choose the correct "inserting station" to obtain the correct month sticker for each one of the over 3 million renewals.

Data processing modifications are estimated to require 282 days at a cost of \$162,700. The cost of additional month stickers is \$195,500. Thus, total one-time cost is \$358,200.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications:

This estimate assumes DOT could actually undertake DP work. However, DOT's DP staff is extremely limited; and some enacted legislation cannot currently be implemented. This project would redirect staff committed to DP system redesign and other project areas, resulting in further delay in those areas.

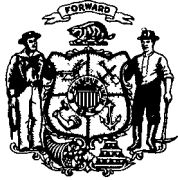

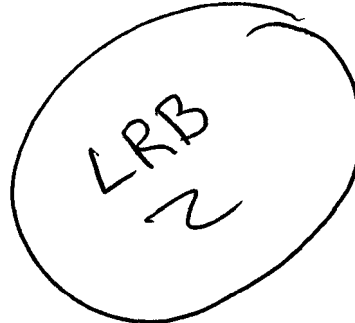

Section 2 of LRB-3521/2 (page 2, line 16 - page 3, line 3):

Current S. 341.15(1m)(b) refers to registration decal or tag issued for trucks and any other vehicles for which one plate is issued. Because the vehicles for which one plate is issued are also the vehicles eligible for quarterly registration, these vehicles receive a sticker which is a combination month/year sticker. Therefore, the reference in this LRB draft to placing the month sticker on the lower-left corner of the plate and the year sticker on the lower-right corner of the plate is technically impossible to achieve.

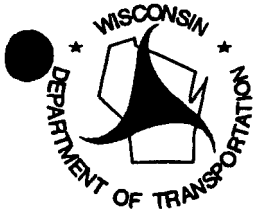

Section 2 of LRB-352112 (page 2, line 16 - page 3, line 3):

Current S. **341.15(1m)(b)** refers to registration decal or tag issued for trucks and any other vehicles for which one plate is issued. Because the vehicles for which one plate is issued are also the vehicles eligible for quarterly registration, these vehicles receive a sticker which is a combination month/year sticker. Therefore, the reference in this LRB draft to placing the month sticker on the lower-left corner of the plate and the year sticker on the lower-right corner of the plate is technically impossible to achieve.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) may issue one insert tag or decal for a vehicle whenever its registration is renewed in lieu of issuing two new registration plates or, for certain vehicles, one new registration plate. The vehicle owner is required to place the insert tag or decal on the rear (or, if only one registration plate is issued for the vehicle, the front) registration plate in the manner directed by DOT.

This bill provides that DOT may issue two insert tags or decals for each registration plate it has issued for a vehicle in lieu of issuing a new registration plate. One insert tag or decal shall specify the month of registration and be placed on the lower left-hand corner of the registration plate, and one insert tag or decal shall specify the year of registration and be placed on the lower right-hand corner of the registration plate.

~~Under~~ current law, a person who operates a vehicle without displaying an insert tag or decal issued for that vehicle may be required to forfeit not more than \$200. This bill provides that a person who operates a vehicle with an insert tag or decal that has been placed on a registration plate in a location other than the location specified by this bill may be required to forfeit not more than \$25.
