Thanks again for taking this one!
In summary:

Under current law, a person who wants to get a disabled fishing license must go to a DNR office & give evidence of disability. The requester wants the person to be able to go to any licensing agent w/ evidence of disability and then get a "temporary" license that is valid for 2 weeks. This should give DNR time to examine the disability evidence & determine eligibility. When DNR determines the person is eligible, it sends a permanent license to replace the temporary one.

I believe they want to keep the same license fee but increase the issuing fee for the agent by 50¢. ^{disabled Veteran} you will also have to look at the Governor's bill for this session concerning license fees in s. 29.563(3) (AB 254). That bill changes the fee from \$4.25 to \$2.25.

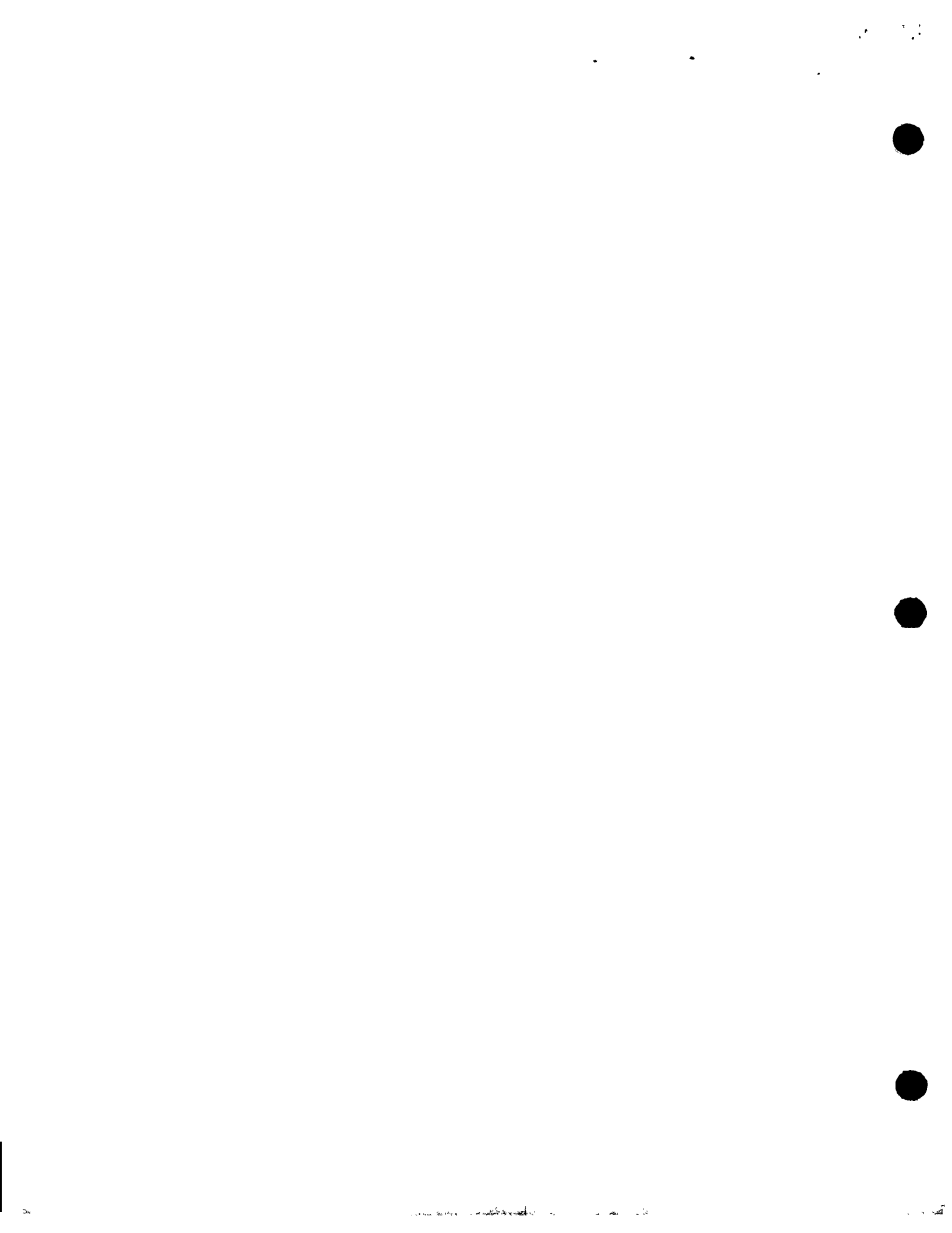

Analysis

⑨ Under current law, the department of natural resources (DNR) and the agents that DNR appoints (issuing agents) may issue annual fishing licenses to state residents who have certain disabilities (disabled persons). An issuing agent may keep 50^{cents} of each fishing license fee.

⑨ This bill provides that, upon receipt of an application for an annual fishing license for a disabled person, an issuing agent shall ^{must} forward the application to DNR and issue the person a temporary fishing license valid for 14 days. DNR must grant or deny the application within this 14-day period. Finally, the bill provides that an issuing agent may keep 75^{cents} of the fishing license fee.
