

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 779**

March 10, 2000 – Offered by Representative GROTHMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 1g.** 440.26 (2) (c) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

4 440.26 **(2)** (c) 2. An individual who has been convicted in this state or elsewhere
5 of a felony and who has not been pardoned for that felony is not eligible for a license
6 under this section, unless the conduct on which that felony conviction is based is no
7 longer punishable as a felony under the laws of this state as of the date of the
8 application for the private detective license.”.

9 **2.** Page 2, line 1: delete “**1**” and substitute “**1r**”.

10 **3.** Page 2, line 9: delete the material beginning with “and” and ending with
11 “felony” on line 11.
