~~This amendment provides funding for emergency system upgrades (ie. sirens, shelters) in Chippewa and Dunn counties.~~

~~The amendment also provides funding for installation of an infrared camera on a lightweight aircraft owned by the Chippewa Squadron, a local branch~~ Wisconsin Civil Air Patrol. If this camera were to be installed, it would be used across all of northern Wisconsin (available to all public-safety agencies north of a line from La Crosse to Green Bay) to assist local agencies with disaster assessment, searches for missing persons, pursuits, **drug** enforcement and other investigations. Requesting agencies will be responsible for travel costs and necessary repairs. Chippewa County Government will maintain ownership and responsibility for insurance coverage and maintenance.


