**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**  
Also under current law, Indian gaming receipts are deposited in an appropriation to the department of administration (DOA). The bill requires an annual transfer from that appropriation to a new appropriation to the department of natural resources to provide law enforcement aids for enforcing laws that regulate snowmobiles and the operation of snowmobiles.

11 to counties as appropriated under s. 20.370 (5) (ek) and (es). On or before June 1, a  
12 county shall file with the department on forms prescribed by the department a  
13 detailed statement of the costs incurred by the county in the enforcement of this  
14 chapter during the preceding May 1 to April 30. The department shall audit the  
15 statements and determine the county's net costs for enforcement of this chapter. The  
16 department shall compute the state aids on the basis of 100% of these net costs and  
17 shall pay these aids on or before October 1. If the state aids payable to counties  
18 exceed the moneys available for such purpose, the department shall prorate the  
19 payments.
