# **1999 BILL**

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AN ACT ...; relating to: the speed of personal watercraft on certain lakes.

# Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, motorboats, including personal watercraft, may not be operated in excess of slow-no-wake speed on lakes of 50 acres or less, except when those lakes serve as thorough fares between for more navigable lakes. The department of natural resources may modify or waive this prohibition for particular lakes if it finds that public safety would not be impaired.

This bill expands the prohibition, with certain exceptions, as it applies to personal watercraft. Under the bill no person may operate a personal watercraft in excess of 'slow-n&wake speed on lakes of 200 acres or less, except when those lakes serve as thoroughfares between 2/or more navigable lakes. Under the exceptions, a town may enact an ordinance that exempts a lake that is entirely within its jurisdiction from the prohibition. A town may also enact an ordinance that expands the prohibition so that it applies to lakes of 300 acres or less if the lakes are entirely within its jurisdiction.
