





This bill prohibits the owner or lessee of a large passenger vehicle from permitting the operation of the vehicle unless each door leading to the passenger seating compartment is equipped with a handle that is operable from within the compartment. The bill also requires that each lock on a door leading to the passenger seating compartment is operable from within the compartment. This bill reduces the minimum passenger capacity from 9 to 7 persons, including the driver. The bill now applies to more vehicles, including minivans.

This bill adds an exception to allow the use of OEM child safety door latches.

This bill does not apply to police vehicles.
