Representative Lassa:

As I discussed with Josh, the proration language is unnecessary, so this draft deletes that language. I also added the phrase "to the extent feasible" on page 3, line 1, because it seems unlikely that the same number of suburban (or rural) school districts will be eligible for grants as urban school districts. For example, I assume that if six urban school districts, two rural school districts and one suburban school district are eligible for grants, you would want all eligible school districts to receive grants, as opposed to requiring DPI to award only one grant to each kind of school district.
