Joshua -

I will be returning the fiscal estimate for AB829 to DOA today. However, you may want to talk to the LRB drafter or the Fiscal Bureau about how the bill was drafted. According to our budget shop, the bill transfers funds from the TANF appropriation from DWD to DPI, but it does not increase our authority to expend the TANF. Both things need to happen - we need to be given the authority to expend the TANF (because the bill increases TANF expenditures) and required to transfer it to DPI.

Representative Lassa:

This amendment makes a technical correction. The cross-reference on page 2, line 1, should have read s. 20.445 (3) (md), not s. 20.455 (3) (md).

Also, as I discussed with Josh, DWD has the authority under the bill to transfer the money to DPI. According to Joanne Simpson of the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, there is money in the DWD TANF appropriation which the Governor put in unallotted reserve after vetoing several allocations under s. 49.175 in the 1999 Wisconsin Act 9 (the biennial budget act). Thus, there is no need to increase DWD's appropriation as there is surplus money that has already been appropriated to DWD. Furthermore, section 3 of the bill directs DWD to allocate \$150,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 for transfer to DPI and section 4 (2) of the bill directs that the money be transferred on July 1, 2000. These provisions give DWD the necessary authority to expend the money. There is no need to provide DWD with any additional authority.
