

**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 838**

March 20, 2000 – Offered by Representative HOVEN.

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 168.045 of the statutes; **relating to:** the sale of gasoline  
2           containing methyl tertiary butyl ether and granting rule-making authority.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3           **SECTION 1.** 168.045 of the statutes is created to read:

4           **168.045 Methyl tertiary butyl ether in gasoline. (1)** (a) From May 1, 2000,  
5           or the effective date of this paragraph .... [revisor inserts date], whichever is later,  
6           to April 30, 2002, no person may sell or offer for sale gasoline that contains more than  
7           2% of methyl tertiary butyl ether by volume.

8           (b) From May 1, 2002, to April 30, 2003, no person may sell or offer for sale  
9           gasoline that contains more than 1% of methyl tertiary butyl ether by volume.

10          (c) Beginning on May 1, 2003, no person may sell or offer for sale gasoline that  
11          contains more than trace amounts of methyl tertiary butyl ether, as determined  
12          under rules promulgated by the department.
