Amendment to Assembly Bill 838

Provisions of Amendment:

- 1.) Effective May 1, 2000, or the day after publication, whichever is later, no person may sell or offer for sale gasoline that contains more than 2% of methyl tertiary butyl ether.
- 2.) Effective May 1, 2002, no person may sell or offer for sale gasoline that contains more than 1% of methyl tertiary butyl ether.
- 3.) Effective May 1, 200~~2~~³, no person may sell or offer for sale gasoline that contains more than trace amounts of methyl tertiary butyl ether ~~has been added~~ as provided by rules adopted by the Department of Commerce, but must be less than 1 percent.
- 4.) Require the Department of Commerce to adopt rules to enforce this act and to create a penalty (under COMM 48).
