This bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for digital broadcasting equipment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 77.54 (45) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 77.54 **(45)** The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use or other
- 5 consumption of digital broadcasting equipment purchased and used by a radio or
- 6 television station.
- 7 Section 2. Effective date.
