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- 4) A possible cost may be incurred by the school bus operators and ultimately school districts and local jurisdictions if total seating in a school bus is reduced by the requirement to have students seated only in designated seating locations with installed safety belts. Federal regulation does not specify the number of students that can sit on a school bus seat; this is determined by the school bus manufacturer. Schools may require additional buses to transport the same number of students due to reduced seating capacity per bus.
- 5) An additional cost may be incurred by a school district or school which decides to place "attendants" on school buses equipped with safety belts to ensure that the safety belts are used properly by all of the students and not ignored or used as weapons. The cost of these attendants and their use state-wide is impossible to estimate.
