

## 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 873

March 13, 2000 – Introduced by Representatives KESTELL, LEIBHAM, OWENS, HASENOHRL, AINSWORTH, GOETSCH, SERATTI, SPILLNER, STASKUNAS, BLACK, SHERMAN and WALKER, cosponsored by Senators ROESSLER, ERPENBACH, ROSENZWEIG and HUELSMAN. Referred to Committee on Highway Safety.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 346.57 (4) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** speed limit at certain  
2             intersections marked with school crossing signs.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current law requires a motorist approaching an intersection marked with a “school crossing” sign to slow to 15 miles per hour or slower when children are present.

This bill requires a motorist approaching an intersection marked with a “school crossing” sign to slow to 15 miles per hour or slower when any child or any school crossing guard is present.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3             **SECTION 1.** 346.57 (4) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4             346.57 (4) (b) Fifteen miles per hour when passing an intersection properly  
5             marked with a “school crossing” sign of a type approved by the department when  
6             children are any child or a school crossing guard is present.

7             **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**
