

1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 882

March 15, 2000 – Introduced by Representatives SYKORA, SUDER, PORTER, MUSSER, F. LASEE, GUNDERSON, PETROWSKI, PLOUFF and PETTIS, cosponsored by Senator ZIEN. Referred to Joint survey committee on Tax Exemptions.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 77.54 (45) of the statutes; **relating to:** a sales tax and use tax
2 exemption for gun safes.
