SECTION 1 20.370 (5) (cw) of the statutes is created to read:

20.370.(5) (cw) Recreation aid - supplemental snowmobile trail aids. As a continuing appropriation, from the snowmobile account in the conservation fund an amount equal to the amount calculated under s. 350.12 (4) (bg) 2. for the purposes specified in 350.12 (4) (b).

SECTION 2 350.12 (3j) (b) is amended to read:

350.12 (3j) (b) The fee for a trail use sticker issued for a snowmobile that is exempt from registration under sub. (2) (b) or (bn) is \$12.25 \$19.25. A trail use sticker issued for such a snowmobile may be issued only by the department and persons appointed by the department and expires on June 30 of each year.

SECTION 3 350.12 (4) (b) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, is amended to read:

350.12 (4) (b) Trail aids and related costs. (intro.) 
