The funds are provided from existing balances in the Conservation Fund, so the bill neither increases nor decreases revenues.  All-Terrain Vehicle Account Spending This bill provides 4.0 FTE conservation warden positions and \$316,000 in FY 01 from the all-terrain vehicle account.  Water Resource Account Spending The bill also authorizes the Department to spend an additional \$850,000 from the water resources account for lake protection grants in FY 01, and authorizes additional activities for which those grant funds may be used. Because local governments voluntarily apply for lake protection grants, which require a local match, this bill will both increase revenues and costs—permissively—to local governments. Any increased workload associated with administering these grants will be absorbed in the Department's budget. The bill also provides \$500,000 in one-time funding in FY 01 from the water resources account for recreation boating and other projects. In addition, the bill provides \$50,800 from the water resources account in FY 01 and a FTE position for a statewide rivers coordinator.  Fish & Wildlife Account Spending This bill also provides FTE positions and \$239,200 in FY 01 from the fish & wildlife account for a wildlife technician, a fisheries biologist, and a fisheries management technician. In addition, the bill provides \$50,000 in FY 01 from the fish & wildlife account to provide funding to promote activities related to making hunting and fishing opportunities more available to the public. This bill also creates an appropriation with \$300,500 in expenditure authority to provide matching grants on a dollar for dollar basis to maintain and develop the Glacial and Western Habitat Restoration Areas and to maintain and develop areas under the Wetland Reserve Program. To the extent that local governments apply for these grants, this bill will both increase revenues and costs to those local governments. Finally, the bill provides \$1.7 m
