- 3. The proposal specifies that registry form be designed and maintained by the Wisconsin Donor Registry. WisDOT expects the on-going costs for the form supply will also be covered by the Wisconsin Donor Registry. (By statute, the "donor dots" form is currently provided to WisDOT by the Wisconsin Organ Procurement Organizations.)
- 4. If the new registry form is combined onto the "donor dots" form sent by WisDOT with driver renewal notices, there should be no additional postage costs. (Currently from 1 to 5 inserts are sent with the renewal form.) If the enrollment form is designed as a separate document from the "donor dot" form, there may be additional postage costs for some renewal mailings. About 900,000 renewals are mailed each year. Additional postage costs will be covered by the Wisconsin Donor Registry.
- 5. WisDOT will develop the programming to provide the electronic names and addresses from the driver license file of applicants who answered affirmatively to the organ donor question, to the Wisconsin Donor Registry. The data will be downloaded 4 times a year, onto magnetic media provided by the Wisconsin Donor Registry. One time costs to develop the programming = 3 hours @ \$16.052 (ISC Comp professional Senior) and computer costs of about\$60 = \$108. On-going costs to provide the data quarterly are negligible
