Assembly Bill 924 mandates three courses of action that would have a fiscal effect to DWD and W-2 agencies.					
AB 924 requires DWD to implement a program to provide training to Financial and Employment Planners and Supportive Services Planners on how to identify victims of domestic violence and how to maintain the safety and confidentiality of these individuals. DWD currently offers an optional training course of this nature that costs approximately \$1100 per session for 30 participants. If the intent of the legislation is that DWD certify that all FEP's and SSP's receive this training, it is anticipated that 2,300 workers would need this course to satisfy the statutory mandate. For 77 sessions, the total cost for this provision is \$84,800.					
Although it cannot be accurately estimated, it is also assumed the local W-2 agencies would have costs associated with sending the appropriate staff to the new required training.					
This legislation also requires DWD to develop a standardized assessment tool to facilitate the identification of victims of domestic violence. The additional workload created by this provision would need to be absorbed by existing staff.
