35.83 (4s) ~~The~~ Upon application? the chief clerks of the legislature shall promptly send to each county clerk, to the Milwaukee County Law Library, and ~~upon application,~~ to each state university, college and public library in this state, copies of all legislative documents together with proper filing appliances for all sessions. Each county clerk who receives legislative documents under this subsection shall keep these documents open to public inspection in the clerk's office.

SECTION 2. **Initial applicability.** This act first applies with respect to legislative documents published for the 2001-2002 legislative session.

This bill **provides** instead for the chief clerks to promptly send copies of all legislative documents to each county clerk or to the Milwaukee county law library upon request of the clerk or library. The bill also directs each county clerk who elects to receive the documents to keep them open to public inspection in the clerk's office.

Because it will take some time to notify county clerks and the Milwaukee county law library of the change in policy and because by the time this draft would become law, probably 95% of the legislative documents for the current legislative session would have been distributed, I made this draft effective with the next legislative session. Please let me know if this is not in accord with your intent. ✓

→ 3. In reviewing the current text of s. 35.85 (11), stats., I noted that the text of s. 35.85 (ll), stats., does not correlate with the text of s. 35.85 (intro.), stats., which concerns DOA document distribution. I have therefore renumbered this statute to s. 35.83 (4s), stats. Section 35.83, stats., relates to non-DOA document distribution. ✓
