Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate Under this bill, if the building commission leases or purchases a corectional facility constructed in Douglas County by a private person, the correctional facility is treated as enumerated in the state building program. In addition, under the bill, the building commission may not lease or purchase any such building unless the person constructing it has complied with prevailing wage requirements applicable to public works projects. This bill provides general statutory authority that does not mandate any expenditure of funds. No information regarding the size, scope or design of the project, the intended security level, or costs associated with lease or purchase are indicated in the bill. The Department of Corrections is therefore, unable to determine the fiscal impact of the bill at this time.
