- AN ACT *to create* 78.018 of the statutes; **relating to:** reducing the motor vehicle
- 2 fuel tax rate.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill decreases the motor vehicle fuel tax by 3 cents per gallon of motor vehicle fuel. Under current law, the revenue from the motor vehicle fuel tax is credited to the transportation fund. This bill transfers \$93,000,000 from the general fund to the transportation fund.

- **SECTION 1.** 78.018 of the statutes is created to read:
- **78.018 Adjustment in the year 2000.** On July 1, 2000, the rate of the tax
- 5 imposed under s. 78.01 (1) is decreased by 3 cents.
- 6 Section 2. Appropriation changes.
