

1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 956

March 30, 2000 – Introduced by Representatives CULLEN, KRUG, BOCK, BERCEAU, BOYLE, CARPENTER, COGGS, COLON, GRONEMUS, HASENOHRL, KREUSER, KRUSICK, LASSA, MEYER, MILLER, MORRIS-TATUM, PLOUFF, POCAN, REYNOLDS, RICHARDS, RILEY, RYBA, SCHOOFF, SHERMAN, SINICKI, STASKUNAS, STEINBRINK, TURNER, WASSERMAN, WILLIAMS, WOOD and YOUNG. 1 **AN ACT** *to create* 78.018 of the statutes; **relating to:** reducing the motor vehicle
2 fuel tax rate.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill decreases the motor vehicle fuel tax by 3 cents per gallon of motor vehicle fuel. Under current law, the revenue from the motor vehicle fuel tax is credited to the transportation fund. This bill transfers \$93,000,000 from the general fund to the transportation fund.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 78.018 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **78.018 Adjustment in the year 2000.** On July 1, 2000, the rate of the tax
5 imposed under s. 78.01 (1) is decreased by 3 cents.
