Joint rule 14 (title): The title of this rule is amended to reflect its content fully.

Joint rule 44 (2) (b): The position of director of legislative attorneys no longer exists. The position of deputy chief is substituted as one of the persons permitted to initial the deletion of a "FE" symbol.

Joint rule 51 (2) and (4): The parallel statute to joint rule 51, relating to drafting privileges at the legislative reference bureau, was changed in the 1997 session to remove drafting privileges from those agencies of Wisconsin state government which are not created in certain chapters of the statutes. This rule is changed to conform to that change in the statutes.

Joint Rule 52 (1) (e): This joint rule provides that the budget bill does not have a long, detailed relating clause. This provision is changed to also apply to other lengthy bills that encompass multiple subjects and that are introduced at the request of the governor.

Joint rule 59: The authority for explanative notes to be included in executive budget bills is deleted and the authority is transferred from the revisor of statutes to the chief of the legislative reference bureau to permit explanative notes to appear in the Wisconsin Acts and session law volumes. The legislative reference bureau prepares the Wisconsin Acts and session law volumes and the revisor prepares the statutes. The revisor retains the discretion over notes to be included in the statutes.


