Whereas, African-Americans have both maintained a rich distinctive culture and have made major contributions to American culture in general; and

Whereas, through the contributions of such African-Americans as the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., El-Hajj Malik El-Shabbazz, Shirley Chisholm and Reverend Jesse Jackson, America's views of itself and of the world have grown to incorporate new ideas and directions; and

other aspects of their cultural traditions; now, therefore, be it
Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the
Wisconsin legislature commend African–Americans for their cultural achievements
and recognize the value of those achievements to African-Americans and to other
Americans; and, be it further
Resolved, That in order to encourage everyone in this state to recognize and
salute the richness of African-American culture, the members of the Wisconsin
legislature declare February "African-American Cultural Heritage Month".
