1 **Relating to:** commending the University of Wisconsin-River Falls for its
2 contributions to the quality of life in Wisconsin over the past 125 years.

3 Whereas, in 1874 a State Normal School was established in River Falls to train
4 teachers for northwestern Wisconsin, making the school the fifth public higher
5 education institution in the new State of Wisconsin; and

6 Whereas, through the past 125 years, the University of Wisconsin-River Falls
7 has taken tremendous strides as a comprehensive institution of higher learning to
8 expand its educational offerings to more than 40 undergraduate and graduate
9 programs in education, the sciences, humanities, liberal arts, business and
10 agriculture; and

11 Whereas, its student body has expanded from a few hundred men and women
12 attending classes in a single building to a population now numbering more than
13 5,600 persons on a campus of 25 buildings; and

1 Whereas, the institution's educational and social impact can be measured in the
2 value of its curricular offerings, in its quality teaching, in the significance of its
3 research endeavors, and in the prominence of its outreach and service; and

4 Whereas, through the expertise and dedication of its faculty and staff, its
5 colleges and school have gained a select national reputation for excellence; and


6 Whereas, the University of Wisconsin-River Falls has welcomed and educated
7 exceptional generations of men and women who, as alumni, have asserted an
8 extraordinary impact on the social, cultural, economic and political life of the State
9 of Wisconsin, the United States of America, and the world; now, therefore, be it

If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
