1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Lynn E. Stalbaum.

2 Whereas, Lynn E. Stalbaum was born on May 15, 1920, in Waterford,
3 Wisconsin, and died on June 27, 1999, in Washington, D.C.; and

4 Whereas, Mr. Stalbaum was educated in Racine County rural schools and
5 graduated from the Racine County Agriculture School in 1936; and

6 Whereas, during World War II, he served aboard a U.S. Navy destroyer in the
7 South Pacific; and

8 Whereas, Mr. Stalbaum served in the Wisconsin senate from 1955 to 1964,
9 where he was elected minority caucus chairman in the 1957, 1959 and 1961
10 sessions and assistant minority leader in the 1963 session; and

11 Whereas, Mr. Stalbaum’s former legislative colleagues have described him “as
12 a legislator who had the maddening tendency to expect reason to dominate
13 legislative debate”; and
