6	Whereas, Merrill Stalbaum served 30 years as clerk of the town of Norway and
7	also served as a member of the Racine County School Committee; and
8	Whereas, his election to the Wisconsin assembly in 1960 enabled him to join his
9	brother, Senator Lynn Stalbaum, as a member of the Wisconsin legislature; and
10	Whereas, Merrill Stalbaum served on the Joint Committee on Finance, the
11	Joint Committee for the Review of Administrative Rules and the Committee on
12	Municipalities; and
13	Whereas, Merrill Stalbaum represented Racine County in the legislature from
14	1961 to 1973; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the
 Wisconsin legislature salute the life and public service of Merrill E. Stalbaum; and,
 be it further
