4	include members of the minority party from either the assembly or the senate; and
5	Whereas, the report of the committee of conference was crafted primarily in
6	closed–door meetings; and
7	Whereas, 124 of the 132 members of the Wisconsin state legislature were not
8	involved in the crafting of the report; now, therefore, be it
9	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the report of the
10	committee of conference on 1999 Assembly Bill 133 is not amendable, except,
11	notwithstanding Joint Rule 3 and 1999 Senate Joint Resolution 19, in that it may
12	be amended by substituting the Ellis–Jauch sales tax rebate plan for the tax refund
13	plan included by the committee of conference.
