## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This joint resolution requires that at least one member from each house be a member of the minority party.

## Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That:

- **SECTION 1.** Joint rule 3 (intro.) is amended to read:
  - Joint Rule 3 **Committee of conference.** (intro.) In all cases of disagreement between the senate and assembly on amendments, adopted by either house to a bill or joint resolution passed by the other house, a committee of conference consisting of 3 members from each house may be requested by either house, and the other house shall appoint a similar committee. At least one member from each house shall be a
