10	name, the Friends of the State Historical Society; and
11	Whereas, for the past 50 years, this organization of dedicated volunteers has
12	assisted the State Historical Society of Wisconsin in the preservation, advancement
13	and dissemination of information relevant to Wisconsin's proud history; and
14	Whereas, the men and women of this independent volunteer organization have
