## Memorandum

To: LRB Staff Attorneys  
From: Representative Steve Freese

Re: Assembly Resolution denouncing the Ku Klux Klan

---

Please draft a resolution similar in nature to 1997 AR 10 introduced by Rep. Robson. It should contain the following language:

Whereas, Madison, Wisconsin, is a city with a long history of ethnic and racial harmony and diversity and was named "The best city to live in" in 1996; and

Whereas, the Ku Klux Klan plans to hold a rally in Madison on January 16, 1999, to spread its racist, homophobic, anti-Catholic and anti-Semitic messages; and

Whereas, the purpose of the rally is to seek publicity for its message of intolerance, to breed animosity and divide the community; and

Whereas, concerned citizens and organizations plan on holding a counter-demonstration on January 16, 1999; and

Whereas, the counter-demonstration will provide a peaceful forum for citizens who reject hate group tactics and embrace the strength that comes from a diverse community; now therefore, be it

Resolved by the Assembly, That the assembly hereby denounces the hate-filled messages of the Ku Klux Klan; and be it further

Resolved, That the assembly commends the citizens of the city of Madison, and others who take part in rejecting the hate-filled messages of the Ku Klux Klan, in their efforts to build bridges of brotherhood, understanding and mutual respect.

Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
