

1999 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 37

1 **Relating to:** commending Joseph E. Wimmer for his lifelong commitment to public
2 service and the people of Waukesha, Wisconsin, and the United States.

3 Whereas, Joseph E. Wimmer has served our nation, our state and the people
4 of Waukesha County with honor and distinction since joining the United States
5 Army in 1954; and

6 Whereas, Judge Wimmer’s passion for law and justice led him to begin his legal
7 career as Muskego’s assistant city attorney, to accept a promotion as Waukesha
8 County’s assistant district attorney and to utilize his legal knowledge and expertise
9 as a Waukesha County circuit court judge for the last 8 years; and

10 Whereas, Representative Wimmer was elected to the state assembly in 1982 to
11 represent the citizens of Wisconsin’s 32nd Assembly District and gained a reputation
12 for being fair, honest and a tireless advocate for his constituents; and

13 Whereas, during his tenure in the assembly, Joe Wimmer distinguished himself
14 as a leader among his colleagues in the areas of constitutional law and tax policy by

1 serving as the ranking minority member on the Assembly Committee on Ways and
2 Means; and

3 Whereas, Joe Wimmer’s commitment to community service led him to serve as
4 the president of the Waukesha Noon Lions Club and international director of the
5 International Association of Lions Clubs; now, therefore, be it

6 ***Resolved by the assembly, That*** the members of the assembly commend
7 Joseph E. Wimmer for his lifelong commitment to public service and the people of
8 Waukesha, Wisconsin, and the United States and wish Joe and his wife, Sue, a
