March 28, 2000 – Introduced by Representatives JENSEN, FOTI, VRAKAS, DUFF, URBAN, GUNDRUM, JESKEWITZ, GUNDERSON and NASS. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** commending Joseph E. Wimmer for his lifelong commitment to public
