(B) (F) To create assembly rule 7m;

1 relating to: prohibiting certain travel by members of the assembly while the state
2 of South Carolina flies the confederate flag in an official capacity.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution creates an assembly rule that prohibits a member of the assembly from attending or traveling to any meeting or event held or sponsored in whole or in part by a national or regional organization of legislatures that has South Carolina as a member, or by an organization of legislators that has legislators from South Carolina as members, while the state of South Carolina flies the confederate flag in an official capacity.

Resolved by the assembly that:

3 SECTION 1. Assembly rule 7m is created to read:
4 NO ASSEMBLY RULE 7m. Prohibited travel. No member of the assembly may
5 attend or travel to any meeting or event held or sponsored in whole or in part by a
6 national or regional organization of legislatures that has South Carolina as a
7 member, or or by an organization of legislators that has legislators from South
8 Carolina as members, while the state of South Carolina flies the confederate flag in
9 an official capacity.

Assembly Rule 89 provides the procedure to amend assembly rules:

Assembly Rule 89. ^(B) Changing assembly rules. Assembly rules may be rescinded or changed only with the approval of a majority of the current membership by roll call vote.

~~Assembly Rule 89~~ (1) Any proposed change of assembly rules shall be introduced as a resolution.

~~Assembly Rule 89~~ (2) Any resolution affecting assembly rules shall be referred by the presiding officer to the calendar for the 2nd legislative day following introduction, or to a committee. A resolution providing for the adoption of assembly rules at the commencement of a legislative biennium may be taken up immediately upon its introduction if the resolution has been provided to the assembly members-elect of the new legislature at least one week prior to the convening of the session.
