

1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 434

June 24, 1997 - Introduced by Representatives BLACK, J. LEHMAN, WASSERMAN, ROBSON, MURAT SYKORA, CULLEN and PLOUFF, cosponsored by Senators JAUCH and GROBSCHMIDT. Referred to Committee on Ways and Means.

In the 1997-99 school year and in subsequent years, to the amount of revenue increase allowed per pupil in the year increased by the percentage change in the consumer price index.

- 1 **AN ACT to create** 121.91 (4) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** increasing a school
- 2 district's revenue limit by the amount spent for school security measures.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law limits the increase in the total amount of revenue that a school district may receive from general school aids and property taxes in a school year to \$200 per pupil. Several exceptions are provided. For example, if a school district increases the services that it provides by adding responsibility for providing a service transferred to it from another governmental unit, its revenue limit is increased by the cost of that service.

This bill provides that a school district's revenue limit is increased by an amount equal to the amount spent by the school district for measures designed to prevent criminal activity in schools.
