- 1 AN ACT *to amend* 125.68 (4) (a) of the statutes; **relating to:** hours of sales by
- 2 intoxicating liquor wholesalers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits the premises of a licensed intoxicating liquor wholesaler to be open for the sale of liquor between the hours of 5 p.m. and 8 a.m., except on Saturday the premises may remain open until 9 p.m.

This bill allows these premises to be open for sales until 9 p.m. daily.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 125.68 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 125.68 (4) (a) Wholesalers. No premises for which a wholesale intoxicating
- 5 liquor permit has been issued may remain open for the sale of intoxicating liquor
- between the hours of $5 \underline{9}$ p.m. and 8 a.m., except on Saturday the premises may
- 7 remain open until 9 p.m.
