# 1997 SENATE BILL 424

January 28, 1998 – Introduced by Senators George and Rude cosponsored by Representatives Plais and Sykora. Referred to Committee on Economic Development, Housing and Covernment Operations.

AN ACT to amend 125.68 (4) (a) of the statutes; relating to: hours of sales by

intoxicating liquor wholesalers.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits the premises of a licensed intoxicating liquor wholesaler to be open for the sale of liquor between the hours of 5 p.m. and 8 a.m., except on Saturday the premises may remain open until 9 p.m.

This bill allows these premises to be open for sales until 9 p.m. daily.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.68 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

125.68 (4) (a) Wholesalers. No premises for which a wholesale intoxicating liquor permit has been issued may remain open for the sale of intoxicating liquor between the hours of 5 9 p.m. and 8 a.m., except on Saturday the premises may remain open until 9 p.m.
