AMENDMENT 1 TO SENATE BILL 8

1 Amendment 1 to SB8 deletes lines 4-7 of SB8 and substitutes the following language
2 amending section 125.68(4)(a):

3 125.68 (4)(a) *Wholesalers.* 1. Except within a 1st class city, nNo premises for which
4 a wholesale intoxicating liquor permit has been issued may remain open for the sale of
5 intoxicating liquor between the hours of 5 p.m. and 8 a.m., except on Saturday the premises
6 may remain open until 9 p.m.

7 2. Within a 1st class city, no premises for which a wholesale intoxicating liquor
8 permit has been issued may remain open for the sale of intoxicating liquor between the hours
9 of 9 p.m. and 8 a.m.

[The purpose of Amendment 1 is to limit the expanded hours to those premises located in a city of the first class.]

1 AN ACT *General*; relating to: hours of sales by intoxicating liquor wholesalers located
2 within 1st class cities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 125.68 (4) (a) [✓] of the statutes is renumbered 125.68(4)(a)1. and
4 amended to read:

5 125.68 (4) (a) ~~Wholesalers~~ 1. No Except as provided in subd. 2. [✓] no premises
6 for which a wholesale intoxicating liquor permit has been issued may remain open
7 for the sale of intoxicating liquor between the hours of 5 p.m. and 8 a.m., except on
8 Saturday the premises may remain open until 9 p.m.
