

1999 SENATE BILL 11

January 20, 1999 – Introduced by JOINT COMMITTEE ON EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS.
Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state
2 of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Public Defenders Association, WFT/AFT,
3 Local 4822, AFL-CIO, for the 1997-99 biennium, covering employes in the
4 public defenders collective bargaining unit, and authorizing an expenditure of
5 funds.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This proposal is introduced under section 111.92 (1) of the statutes. The proposal ratifies the collective bargaining contract for state employes in the public defenders collective bargaining unit negotiated for the 1997-99 biennium under the state employment labor relations act. Currently, statutory program supplement appropriations fund the costs of collective bargaining agreements to the extent that they exceed budgeted costs. The proposal authorizes expenditure of moneys from those appropriations to fund the cost of this agreement.
