January 7, 1998 - Introduced by Senators BRESKE, SHIBILSKI, RUDE, WELCH, GEORGE, WINEKE, ZIEN, SCHULTZ, FITZGERALD, A. 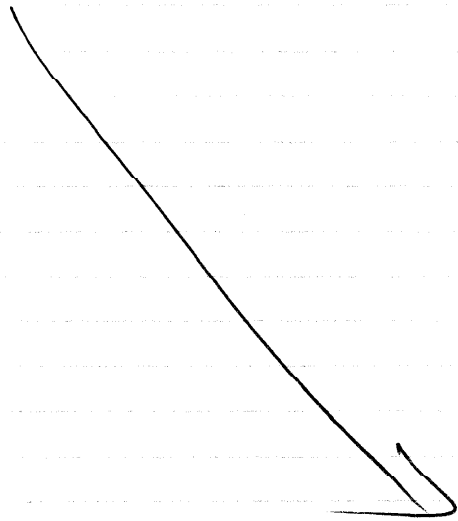
